



Basic Firearm SAFETY RULES

Twelve golden rules of basic firearm safety:

1. Treat all guns as if they are loaded
2. Do not enter a shooting range with a loaded firearm
3. Do not point your firearm at anything that you do not wish to see destroyed
4. Never leave your firearm unattended
5. Do not touch your firearm unless you are on the firing line and instructed to do so by the presiding Range Officer
6. Do not touch someone else's firearm without permission
7. Use only ammunition that has been specifically chambered for your firearm
8. Always point the muzzle of your firearm downrange
9. Do not place your finger on the trigger until you are ready to shoot
10. Be sure you know where the bullet will stop before you pull the trigger; once fired, a bullet cannot be recalled
11. Respect and obey all commands of the Range Officer who has complete control of the range
12. When in DOUBT, ASK for clarification or assistance!
